June 22, Sunday Charity: BLM/Mustangs

Our Ride will be held at Washington Crossing State Park, Titusville, NJ. Located along the Delaware River, just eight miles north of Trenton. The Continental Army, commanded by Gen. George Washington, landed here after its historic crossing of the Delaware River on Christmas night in 1776. The park consists of 1,399 acres in Mercer County and is easily accessible from Routes 29 and 546.

Sept 13&14 Charity: Lusscroft Farm, Sussex County, NJ

In 1914, James Turner, a Montclair stockbroker, invested \$500,000 to invent Lusscroft into a model dairy farm. Twenty-three buildings are still on the property, including the Turner Mansion. This will be our overnight ride, stalls are available. Included in the ride is a afternoon refreshment from 2-4pm, dinner at the Homestead Restaurant and Sunday morning breakfast.

October TBA Charity: Morris County Mounted Police

Lewis Morris Park was the first park opened in Morris County Park System March 1958. It was named after the first NJ State Governor. The park is 1,154 acres and includes a lake, ball fields, camping and picnic areas. Our ride will be led by officers of the Morris County Mounted Unit and we will join them for the annual "Pigs in the Park" picnic.
